Zonta Club of Albany Young Women in Public Affairs Scholarship: For a young woman who has participated in public affairs by recognizing a commitment to the volunteer sector, has evidence of volunteer activities and who has been dedicated to the advancement of the status of women in our nation and worldwide. Applications are in the Guidance Office. DUE DATE: FEBRUARY 15.

Association of Fire Districts of the State of New York, Inc. Ned Carter Scholarship: Student must be related to or be a Firefighter in an affiliated member organization of the Association of Fire Districts of New York and must reside in New York. There are four (4) \$1,500 scholarships available. Applications are in the Guidance Office. DUE DATE: MARCH 3.

Price Chopper's Golub Foundation: Ten scholarships are available to students within the marketing area. Eight of these scholarships are for graduating high school seniors planning to attend college as a fully matriculated, first year student for the fall of 2011. The application is available at www.pricechopper.com. DUE DATE: MARCH 15.

NYSUT Retiree Council 10: This scholarship will be awarded to a 2012 graduating senior pursuing a degree in education at either a two-year college transfer program or a four-year college. This scholarship will be given to one student from each of the four counties represented by RC 10 (Albany, Rensselaer, Saratoga, and Washington). The Community Foundation for the Greater Capital Region:

Ad Club Scholarship (up to \$3,000): For high school seniors or for students entering their junior or senior year at a Capital Region college or university who are majoring in public communications, marketing, graphic arts, public relations, or any other communications-related curriculum.

Gene Robb Journalism Scholarship (up to \$1,500): For a student who must have a clearly demonstrated interest in journalism and provide samples of journalistic work. Personal recommendations are required.

Ruth Goldstein Memorial Music Scholarship (\$500): For a graduating senior from a Capital Region high school who will continue on to study music education or music performance. Special consideration will be given to students whose major instrument is of the

woodwind family, piano students who accompany others, or students who demonstrate financial need.

National Association of Women in Construction Scholarship: This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to qualified High School Seniors who plan to enroll in an accredited college in a construction-related degree program. Awards are based on need, merit, and a review of the transcript. Applications are available in the Guidance Office. DUE DATE: APRIL 18.

New York State Society of Professional Engineers' Capital District Chapter Scholarship: This scholarship can range from \$1,000 to \$3,000 for high school seniors in the Capital District who intend to study engineering. Rotary Club of Hudson Shores Richard Hunsdorfer-Dr. William A Stewart "Service Above Self" Rotary Award: Eligibility criteria for this award are as follows: any graduating senior entering post-secondary education and resides in the Hudson Shores (and have lived in one of these communities for their entire senior year). Service will count for 50%, scholarship for 25%, and need for the remaining 25%. Applications are in the Guidance Office. DUE DATE: APRIL 20.

Bank of America/Merrill Lynch Palermo Family Scholarship: Applications are in the Guidance Office. DUE DATE: MAY 1.

Capital District Counseling Association: The following scholarships are available to local students who are enrolling at a Capital Region institution:
